He thinks it is a combination of a bad seed mix and a spring planting followed by the extreme dry weather. He has agreed to replant certain areas and offered to do this for free. However, the Councillors all felt that we should pay him but at a reduced cost as he certainly put in a lot of work even though the results were disappointing. He is going to switch to an Autumn sowing and a change in seed mixture with more yellow rattle to keep the grass from taking over. He will also tackle the thistles and weeds by spot treatment until the verge is established.
